

# III Obert Internacional d'escacs actius del Mas Guinardó

## Regulations

### 1. Schedule

The tournament will take place on May 12, 2019, from 9:30 to 19:30.

### 2. Participating players

The tournament is open to all players having active licence with International Chess Federation (FIDE), Catalan Chess Federation (FCdE) or Spanish Chess Federation (FEDA).

### 3. Venue of Play

Casal d'Entitats del Mas Guinardó (Pl. Salvador Riera, 2, Barcelona).

The venue is fully adapted for disabled people.

### 4. Round Times

There will be 9 rounds using Swiss Format. Pairings will be performed by means of Swiss Manager. No claim regarding the pairings will be accepted during the tournament unless the arbiter thinks otherwise:

- Sunday morning: 5 rounds (9:30am)
- Sunday afternoon: 4 rounds (4pm)

The first round will start at 9:30am sharp. Welcome reception and collection of fees will start at 8:45am.

### 5. Time Control

15 minutes + 5 seconds per move (15' + 5")

### 6. Groups and ratings

There will be a single group. The tournament will be valid for Rapid FIDE rating and rapid Catalan rating.

### 7. Ranking

The ranking will be computed by considering Rapid FIDE rating.

For those not having it, traditional FIDE rating will be considered. Rapid Catalan rating or the pertinent national rating will be used for those not having the former ratings.

### 8. Tournament Category

The tournament is valid for the XVI Catalan Grand Prix of International Open Chess Tournaments.

- For the general standings: B
- For rating section standings: A

## 9. Price Ceremony

The Prize Ceremony will take place on the same day, once the last round is over, approximately at 19:45. It is mandatory to collect the prize personally with an original photo-id during this ceremony (or by means of a delegate person with a player signed authorization and a copy of their photo-id). Should a minor win a prize, the prize will be awarded to his or her legal representative.

If these conditions are not met, it will be assumed that the awarded player gives up their prize

Registration fees will be waived for those players who are invited by the Organization.

It will be possible to pay the registration fee the same day before the tournament begins, or earlier through a wire transfer to bank account:

In case of doing a transfer the name of the player will have to be filled out or sent via mail to the organization.

The tournament entry fee will have to be paid before the first round.

The maximum tournament capacity is reckoned to be 150 players.

## 11. Time Tolerance

The time to show oneself to a game will be until the flag falls. A non-justified absence to a game will imply the player disqualification from the tournament.

## 12. Venue restrictions and complementary services

Smoking is forbidden in the playing hall and adjacent areas. Nobody, player or not, may have any electronic device switched on during the playing session. Otherwise, the penalty will be the decision of the arbitral team.

In the venue of play there are bar and restaurant services though availability is subjected to municipal licence.

## 13. Committee

There will be no Competition Committee. In order not to interfere with the proper development of the tournament, it will not be possible to present a claim against arbitral decisions during the tournament. In the venue of play there will be official forms that may be used by players to address a written claim to the corresponding bodies of Catalan Chess Federation.

## 14. Tie-Breaking

Ties on the final ranking will be broken by using:

- Particular result
- The order of second, third and fourth tie-breaks will be drawn after the end of the last tournament round among: recursive performance, performance, the average rating of opponents excluding the two lowest-rated opponents.

## 15. Tournament direction

Pep Melendres Inglés, Ramon Povill Batlle and Guillem Subirachs Mancebo constitute the organizing committee of the tournament.

## 16. Arbitral team

The main arbiter will be Frederic Corrigüelas.

## 17. Image rights

Participants grant permission to the organization, the Catalan Chess Federation and third parties, in order to publish, reproduce or use their photographs for the promotion of the tournament, the results of the individual games and the promotion of the game of chess.

In order to assign the players to the rating sections, all tournaments will take into account their FIDE rating. For players with no FIDE rating, their FCE rating will be used, or their FEDA rating if they come from other regions of Spain. If a player is not affiliated to Catalan Chess Federation and has neither a FIDE nor a FEDA rating, he or she will be excluded from rating sections points and standings.

Section prizes cannot be accumulated to any other prize. All prizes will be submitted to the corresponding fiscal retention.
